About the artists

LI Wei Han Rosanna is a ceramicist, design educator and avid collector of paper offering shoes. Her works are full of humourous wordplay and whimsiness, and very often reflect Hong Kong culture. One can easily find her ceramic sculptural works around town, either near MTR stations or Hong Kong airport. She was the Hong Kong Arts Development Council's Artist of The Year for Visual Art Culture in 2020. Her ceramic installation was part of the exhibition "Classics Remix - The Hong Kong Viewpoint" at the Hong Kong Museum of Art in 2019 - 2020. Li also authored an essay on Hong Kong Contemporary Ceramics, A Thing or Two of What I Know (Part One) in 2019 Hong Kong Visual Arts Yearbook.

CHEUNG Wai Sze, Rachel has attained master education in ceramic and glass art at the University of Sunderland in 2004 and the Middlesex University in 2009 respectively. Winner of the Prize of Excellence at the Hong Kong Art Biennial Exhibition 2001, she has thereafter participated in over 30 solo and group exhibitions across different countries. Her works are in the collection of various Hong Kong and Taiwan museums. Cheung is the author of 'New Horizons of Local Ceramic Art in Hong Kong' (2015).

Nutz LUK set up her own studio nutzeramic in 2019 and participated actively in community art and art education. Graduated at Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology in 2009 and received the Pan Gallery Ceramic Art Award (Australia) the following year, Nutz' works have been exhibited in Hong Kong, Macau, China, Japan and Australia.

CHAN Nga Man, Amie was into various academic pursuits across visual art education, visual culture, and ceramic in crafts and design at Hong Kong Baptist University AVA, Chinese University of Hong Kong and Estonian Academy of Arts respectively between 2014 and 2021. In 2015 she was awarded 'Young Creative Entrepreneur Award' and set up Laichankee Studio. Her recent exploration is the relationship between the pottery, people, makers and audience.
